The structure of ESOT grants is based on considering both the primary goal of the proposal (basic/experimental vs. translational/clinical) as well as the position (student/junior/senior faculty).

\$ 40.000 for 1 year awarded by ESOT alternating with AST  
Junior faculty (basic science or clinical)  
Preference will be given to Europeans visiting an US institution (ESOT year) and vice versa (AST year)  
Exchange between AST and ESOT. Awarded every 2 years by ESOT for an AST member and every 2 years by AST for an ESOT member  
Duration: 1 year  
Amount: \$ 40.000/year

**Criteria** Superiority of scientific content or practical impact of skills to be learned will decide on the nominee. European-European travel is preferred to European-outside Europe  
**Deadline** March 1<sup>st</sup> and September 1<sup>st</sup>  
**Reporting** Applicants will receive 2/3 payment when awarded with the grant; payment will be completed after receiving a report within 2 months after completion

**Purpose** Investigator award in relation to organ preservation research

Junior faculty (< 35 years)  
Duration: 1 year  
Amount: € 10.000/year

**Criteria** Superiority of scientific content will decide on the nominee
